2008 TRACK & FIELD SEASON

Enclosed with this edition of SCAN is an analysis based upon the Surrey Ranking Lists of the performances of Surrey athletes in the Under 13 and Under 15 age groups.

It is from this group of athletes that the future of our sport will be made. I believe that we need to ensure that they are encouraged to participate in a range of events and to learn the disciplines of both training and competition. The numbers of athletes achieving the Surrey standard is a measure of how successful we are.

I would hope that clubs look at their figures and then ask themselves why their figures have stayed the same as previous years or have changed. By asking these questions the answers they get should be useful in planning their future development.

Clubs who seek financial support from bodies such as Sport England are asked to provide performance indicators so that they can be measured. I would suggest that the figures shown in the analysis could be used for this purpose.

The high scores by Guildford & Godalming AC in the 2 Girls age groups clearly show that they are being successful. However, I would commend Camberley & District AC for their high scores in the Under 13s particularly when you consider that there is no athletics track in Camberley.

SCOTT v AMUNDSEN - THE DEADLIEST REMATCH ON EARTH

An article in *The Sunday Times* of 28 December 2008 details an event due to start on 1 January 2009. Six teams are taking part in a race, expected to last up to six weeks, to the South Pole which is described as the first since the fateful clash between Roald Amundsen and Robert Falcon Scott in 1912. One of the teams comprises Ben Fogle, James Cracknell and Ed Coats. Ed is described as being a doctor from Bristol who once represented Britain as a decathlete. Many Surrey people will remember him as a member of Guildford & Godalming AC. He won the Surrey U17 Octathlon (1995) and U20 Decathlon (1998) titles and was 14th at the 1999 European Junior (U20) Championships held in Riga, Latvia where he was coached by Chris Richardson.

Alan, who lives nearby, was, as a member of Belgrave Harriers, Surrey Junior Champion for 100 yards (1947/1948/1949) and 220 yards (1948/1949) and Surrey Senior Champion for 440yds (1954). He has maintained an interest in sport through Rugby which he represents on the Croydon Playing Fields Association and through athletics where his wife Heather has competed for Croydon Harriers as a Vet and his son Richard who was Surrey Youth 100m Hurdles champion (1986) and Junior 110m Hurdles champion (1987).
