### SURREY COUNTY AA AGM

Surrey County AA held its AGM recently and elected Anne Roden as its President for the current year.



Below is a part of the introduction made by our Chairman, Tom Pollak:-

Anne was among the thousands of people who came into athletics in this country in the road running boom of the 1980's. Although a competent korfball and netball player she wanted to take part in the London marathon and took part in her first marathon in the capital in 1983, two years after it was founded. She completed a total of five London races. She has a best marathon time of two hours 37 minutes 56 seconds set in the Boston marathon in 1992. She returned to Boston in 2000 when she set a UK women's over 50 veterans age record of 2 hours 54 minutes 21 seconds and that was the last time she ran over the 26 miles 385 yards marathon distnce. She continued to run until four years ago when she was forced to call a halt to her competitive days due to hip problems. Since 2000 she has enthusiastically applied herself to coaching and helping out at her club, South London Harriers, in various capacities she has been young athletes team manager for several seasons. She freely admits she's involved in athletics seven days a week. Her twin brother Tom was a top ultra distance runner and also a member of South London Harriers who won a 24 hour race at Crystal Palace in October 1977.
