ALL-TIME RANKINGS

Back in the Autumn we released a facility on the website to display all-time track & field rankings for all of the standard age groups. The listings are based upon the information contained in the rankings database which, although complete for recent years, is less so the further back in time you go. Initially we set an arbitrary standard which meant that around 20-25 athletes were shown. The release has prompted a response from several whose competitive days were several decades ago but still retain an interest in the sport.

2011 TRACK & FIELD SEASON

Enclosed with this edition of SCAN is an analysis based upon the Surrey Ranking Lists of the performances of Surrey athletes in the Under 13 and Under 15 age groups. It is from this group of athletes that the future of our sport will be made. I believe that we need to ensure that they are encouraged to participate in a range of events and to learn the disciplines of both training and competition. The numbers of athletes achieving the Surrey standard is a measure of how successful we are.

I would hope that clubs look at their figures and then ask themselves why their figures have stayed the same as previous years or have changed. By asking these questions the answers they get should be useful in planning their future development.

Clubs who seek financial support from bodies such as Sport England are asked to provide performance indicators so that they can be measured. I would suggest that the figures shown in the analysis could be used for this purpose.

The figures provide a yearly comparison since of both the relative strength of our clubs and of numbers and quality of performance in the various events for these age groups. The figures shown are extracted from the tabulations shown on the website which cover 2005 - 2011 and the six Under 17, Under 15 & Under 13 age groups. From these figures I have produced the table:

The table shows the total number of Surrey athletes achieving a Surrey standard in at least one event. 2005 is the year that London was announced as the host city for the 2012 Olympics. For it to be said that there is a positive legacy from the Games then one measure could be that the figures shown indicate a rising trend. Although the pattern is not identical across all the age groups it is clear that by 2009 there has been a significant increase in participation (ranging from 20% to 60%) and that the following two years show consolidation in the Under 17s and a continuing rise in the Under 13s & Under 15s.
