# SIR CHRIS CHATAWAY 1931 - 2014

Chris Chataway died on 19<sup>th</sup> January, aged 82, after suffering from cancer for two and a half years. There has been many accounts of his illustrious career as an international athlete and world record holder in the national media. What is less well known is his career as a Surrey athlete during the late 1940s and early 1950s as a member of Walton AC. His name first appears in the Surrey archives in 1949 when he finished third in the County Junior Men's 880 yards final. This was followed by another third place in 1950 this time in the County Junior Cross-Country Championship. He won the County Senior Mile Championship in 1950 in 4:21.6. In 1952 he won the CAU Inter-County One Mile title in 4:13.8.

He is well known for his part in the race that saw Roger Bannister become the first man to break the four-minute mile barrier in 1954. Then in 1955 he became the fourth man to break 4 minutes when he finished second at the British Games with a time of 3:59.8. The Walton AC website reports him being in their team that participated in the London to Brighton relay in April 1950 which also included another who had made his mark in British history, Alan Turing. In his later years he ran for Achilles Club and Thames Hare & Hounds.

# STAN ALLEN 1934 - 2014

Stan Allen died, aged 79, on 1st January 2014 at St George's Hospital, Tooting following a long period of illness. He was a stalwart of Herne Hill Harriers and regularly contested the Surrey Championships from the 1950s through to the 1980s. HHH turned-out 164 runners in the Surrey League on 11<sup>th</sup> January to celebrate the club's 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary and to pay tribute to Stan.

I will be updating the Surrey List of Technical & Ancillary Officials, using data on the UKA officials' database ("Trinity") as at the beginning of March. As you may know from the March 2013 booklet, the level of information about each official given there is dependant on what each official has agreed. In the absence of any information to the contrary, only the official's name is shown. I will be contacting all officials individually again, and ask that you respond to that communication: if officials who were in last year's booklet do not respond, the level of detail disclosed will be the same as for 2013. Again, only UKA Licensed Officials will be included in the Technical Officials list: see comments below re DBS.

Please remember that if you are renewing your CRB (now called DBS), you will need to send the certificate that you receive from the Disclosure and Barring Service to UKA at Athletics Welfare PO Box 332, Sale, Manchester M33 6XL, as UKA no longer get sent a copy directly and your licence cannot be renewed until they have sight of it. It is probably a good idea to take and retain a copy in case the original gets lost in the post.



# 2013 TRACK & FIELD SEASON

Enclosed with this edition of SCAN is an analysis, based upon the Surrey Ranking Lists, of the performances by Surrey athletes in the Under-13 and Under-15 age groups. An analysis showing the Under-13s, Under-15s and Under-17s for the years 2005 - 2013 is available on the county website via a link at the bottom of the Home Page.

The tabulations show a significant rise in the number of athletes achieving a Surrey Standard during 2013 for the Under-13 age groups in most events. There was an improvement in the numbers for the Under-15s as well, but less pronounced than in the Under-13s. With the Under-17s the Men's figures are similar to 2012 whereas the Women's figures show a decline. Are the reduced competitive opportunities for U17s in the new UK Youth Development League a factor here?

There are no surprises regarding the clubs scoring the most points. However, significant improvements were shown by Aldershot, Farnham & District (U13B/U15B), Kingston AC & Polytechnic Harriers (U15B), Walton AC (U13G/U15B/U15G). As in previous years Guildford & Godalming AC are the leading club for female athletes although Herne Hill Harriers took the top spot in the Under-15 Girls for the first time.
