To confirm the importance of this medium there is on page 11 an article showing how the number of information pages read on the SCAA web site is continuing to increase.

I receive information from the information providers and I then publish it with the intention that it should be available to those who need it. I would request that you consult with your colleagues and let me know how successful this process is and make suggestions for any improvements that you think appropriate.

ACTIVE SPORT UPDATE

Surrey

The Surrey Active Sports Partnership has changed its name to 'Surrey Active'.

Sport England with a start date of October 2002 has approved the five-year plan devised by the 'Athletics Action Group'. Some activities are already under way.

Ten coaches have been inducted into the Active Sport Athletics programme and are ready to take part in organised activities.

Several Local Authorities have after school or Saturday programmes in the advanced stages of planning with Surrey Heath in the lead with Saturday sessions between 10 and 11.30 at Tomlinscote School starting on the 25 January. Support for these coaching sessions from clubs and club coaches is important as it is hoped that new keen talents will be interested in joining the club to continue in athletics.

Elspeth Linford, the new RDC for the South East Region, will be contacting clubs to give them a more detailed briefing on Active Sport and what is happening in their area.

The post of Active Sport Development Officer is still to be filled. Following a review the proposed part time hours are increased to eighteen hours per week and there is an improved salary package. Adverts should go out in mid February and the details will be available on the Surrey Athletics web site.



The SCAA web site continues to provide users with access to latest information about Surrey athletics. It is regularly updated with results and news items. In the February 2002 edition of SCAN a graph was displayed showing the actual number of pages read for the period May 2001 to January 2002. The graph below shows the number of pages read per month for each month of 2002. The figures have been "normalised" so that each month is reported on a comparative basis. The process of normalisation is achieved by dividing the number of pages by the number of days in the month and multiplying the result by 30. This explains why in last year's graph January 2002 was reported as 8423 whereas the figure below for the same month is $8151 (= 8423 / 31 \times 30)$. The value for January 2003 for the first 21 days is 13,324 which reflects the desire to read the full results of our Cross Country championships which were added on the Sunday evening.
