MODERNISATION

Athletics is being told it must modernise in order, it appears, to maintain funding support from various Government sources. As a consequence it is likely that changes to the structure of our sport will be implemented that will affect how the sport is administered and how initiatives are delivered for the "benefit" of the clubs and their members. Although attempts are being made at consultation there is a danger that the views of the larger clubs, who are more likely to have someone available to participate in the consultation process, will predominate. Clearly, if the smaller clubs do not participate then they will find it hard to justify complaining if the new structures do not suit them - and it will be too late anyway!

One of the items being discussed is the move to nine regional hubs in England. Not surprisingly, these hubs mirror Sport England's structure. Therefore, we in Surrey could be split between London and the South-East. One of the problems with the Sport England split is that although it conforms to the political geography it does not conform to the sporting geography. Virtually all sports use the ancient county boundaries and organise their activities on that basis. Therefore Sport England has probably chosen the wrong geographical structure for the delivery of support to the grass roots level. London as the capital city should provide "capital city facilities" such as a national stadium but this does not mean that Greater London is, necessarily, a sensible administrative area for Athletics (or any other sport) to choose. It makes no sense for Surrey County AA to have to deal with two hubs and, in effect, set up "Chinese walls" within many of its activities that are of direct benefit to the clubs and their members

Following the comments regarding the drop in numbers attending County Championships there appears to be a question mark over the role of the counties. Although not applicable to all athletes the county structure does provide an important stepping stone for many who aspire to success at the highest levels. County championships and county teams are often the first competitive opportunities outside of the club and are an important step on an athlete's "learning curve". Would athletes be more likely to enter a South-East or London Championship rather than a Surrey Championship? The question has already been posed for London and the athletes could be said to have voted with their feet.

Remember that you are part of our sport and that your views are important. Do not keep them to yourself - let THEM know what you think. UK Athletics and South of England AA would, I am sure, be pleased to receive your comments.
