Two Surrey officials have been elected to positions on the International Association of Athletics Federations.

David Littlewood, one of Britain's most experienced athletics officials, has been voted back onto the IAAF technical committee on which he previously served from 1997 to 1999.

David, a retired schoolmaster, who lives in New Malden, is an international technical official, a member of the panel of IAAF international photofinish judges and a member of the athletics technical commission of the International School Sports Federation He has regularly officiated at Olympic, World, European and Commonwealth Championships and, following his election at the IAAF Congress in Paris, he officiated at the World Championships there as the international photo-finish judge.

He has been secretary of the English Schools Athletics Association since 1992 and served more than 40 years as treasurer of Hercules Wimbledon Athletic Club. Since 1981, he has been chairman of the British Technical Officials Committee and has officiated at more than 100 international meetings in Britain as track judge, track referee, chief photofinish judge or meeting manager.

He was track referee at last year's Commonwealth Games in Manchester, at the 1987 European Junior Championships, the 1989 and 1994 European Cup finals and the 1991 World University Games. He was international photofinish judge at the World Cup in South Africa in 1998, and the World indoor championships in Barcelona and Lisbon in 1995 and 2001. He was referee at the World half-marathon championship in Bristol in 2001 and chief photofinish judge and member of the technical organising committee at this year's IAAF World Indoor Championships in Birmingham. He has already been appointed international technical official for the IAAF World Indoor Championships in Budapest next Spring. He has also been referee for the men's race at the London marathon for the past 19 years.

"It will be a priviledge to work with outstanding colleagues in the technical field from around the world, many of whom I have known for several years. My appointment will also provide an excellent opportunity to bring the deliberations of the IAAF technical committee back to the highly respected group of leading officials in the UK, known for their technical expertise," he said.

Our president Bridget Cushen, a member of Sutton and District Athletic Club, has been elected to the veterans committee of the IAAF. A former international track and cross country athlete, she served as women's representative on the World Association of Veterans Athletics between 1983 and 1993, a period when female team participation in the World Championships increased by more than half.

It has been largely through Bridget's involvement that women have achieved equality with men in all athletics events introducing hammer throwing, triple jumping, steeplechasing and the pole vaulting during the 1980's. She was guest speaker at the IAAF seminar on the International Year of Women in Athletics in Granada in October 1998 when she spoke on athletics and ageing. At home, she has been secretary of the British Masters Athletic Federation since 1984 and was on the organising committee of the first European Veterans Indoor Championships held at Birmingham in 1997.

Structural changes

Starting in June this year the county web site underwent a change of structure and a cosmetic change to the style of the links to the various sections. Because of the increasing amount of information being held and the need to relate activities across years it was decided to structure the site by discipline (ie Cross Country, Race Walking, Road, Sportshall and Track & Field).

Within each discipline there is a further sub-division by competition year. Then within each 'year' there is a further split by categories such as County Championships; Inter-County events and Other events (eg regional/national/inter-national champs). With this structure it will be easier to progress from one year to the next without a significant year-end reshuffle of pages.

A new "contents" page has been provided which gives an index to each individual championship, inter-county event and other event.

Track & Field Championships database.

Over the past months a database of county track & field championship results has been built up. At present it holds details of over 7000 performances including all results from the outdoor championships from 1998 - 2003. It is planned to add more results over the next few months. Whilst it is possible to extract all the results, users are provided with facilities to select the results based upon certain criteria. These include specifying a single event and/or a single age group and/or a single club and/or winners only and/or finals only. If you choose a specific event it also possible to specify a "standard" so that only performances better than or equal to the standard are selected.

The database is still being developed with new selection criteria being added in the future. Users will be requested to help with tidying-up the information. In particular as entry forms are not always clearly written the same athlete can have their spelt differently from one championship to the next. Also prior to 1998 the results do not show the athletes first name but only an initial so help will be sought to correct and complete the names. In order that the selection by club is complete the database holds the club and school/college/university in separate fields - therefore, if an athlete has entered under, say, the name of their school, it will be possible to retrospectively add the name of their club.

You are invited to try out the database and send in your comments.

Visitor statistics

Meaningful visitor stats are notoriously difficult to obtain. It is easy to count the number of times a page is accessed but each access of the home page does not equate to new user or a new session. Since August a new method of counting sessions has been used which shows a value of around 500 sessions per week. This compares with the previous statistic of pages read which is currently around 16,000 per month.
