GEOFF DAVIS 1931 - 2004

Geoff Davis, a life vice president of Surrey County AA has died after a long illness, aged 73.

Davis was a past president of both Belgrave Harriers and the former Surrey Athletic Club and was the pivotal figure who steered through the merger of the men's section of Surrey Athletic Club with Belgrave Harriers which helped enable Belgrave qualify for the British Athletics League in September 1982. Following the amalgamation he was elected president of Belgrave Harriers.

He first became involved with club athletics after the second world war when he joined Polytechnic Harriers, then based at Chiswick, as a sprinter. He competed in relay teams alongside the legendary E McDonald Bailey. After retiring from active athletics and having moved to New Malden, his interest in the sport was rekindled when one of his daughters took up athletics and he took her along to the old Norbiton track on the site of the current Kingsmeadow Stadium. She joined Surrey Athletic Club and it was not long before Geoff became involved and in the early 1970's took over as secretary, later becoming president By the end of the 1970's the club was suffering desperately from a shortage of administrators and officials and Davis found himself taking on more administrative roles in a bid to keep Surrey AC going.

Eventually it became too much for him and around 1980 he approached Belgrave Harriers, proposing amalgamation. It did not happen immediately but within two years the men's sections of the two clubs did merge. However, Surrey AC's women's section under the late Stan Belton, refused to be part of the new set-up and remained at Norbiton becoming the Royal Borough of Kingston AC. Subsequently, as part of a deal thrashed out by Kingston Council when Kingstonian Football Club moved from their Richmond Road ground to Kingsmeadow, a modern floodlit track was provided alongside the football ground and, at the same time, the famous Polytechnic Harriers moved over from Chiswick to form the current Kingston AC and Polytechnic Harriers club.

When his career with Pearl Assurance took him away from London, to Peterborough, true to form, he became heavily involved in athletics in Cambridgeshire. He was chairman of both Peterborough Athletic Club and Cambridgeshire County Athletic Association and was also Cambridgeshire officials secretary until around a year ago.

He is survived by his wife Moira and their three children, Tim, Ann and Nicky.

Surrey County AA secretary Don Turner was among mourners at his funeral which was held at a packed Holy Trinity Church, Orton Longueville, near Peterborough on December 9.
