The Sportshall Regional Final, between teams from Essex, Sussex, Kent, Middlesex and Surrey was a very strongly fought match with individual honours being spread more widely than usual. The team beat Essex by the slim margin of 3 points.

NATASHA DANVERS-SMITH WINS SILVER MEDAL

Natasha Danvers-Smith showed that she was returning to her pre-maternity form when she finished second in the 400M Hurdles. She then had the misfortune to be the cause of further headlines when she was disqualified for taking up the wrong position for the second takeover in the final of the 4x400m relay in which the English team were first to cross the line. Martyn Rooney was the focus of much attention following his performances which included beating Roger Black's National Junior 400M record in the semi-finals when he clocked 45.35.

IAAF World Cross Country, Fukuoka, Japan, 1-2 April 2006

Natalie HARVEY was 4th Briton home in the Womens Long Course (8K) event held on 1st April. She finished 40th with a time of 27:22. There were 98 finishers. The GB & NI team were 7th.

Eleanor BAKER was the first Briton home in the Womens Short Course (4K) event held on 2nd April. She finished 44th with a time of 13:45. There were 91 finishers. As only 3 runners were representing GB & NI they did not finish a team.

Tony Smith

Tony Smith, who for two decades ran the summer Monday night Sri Chinmoy road race series in Battersea Park as well as being involved in organising other running events, died on February 23 after a lengthy battle against cancer.

Smith, who was in his 60's and lived in Cardigan Road, Barnes (on the Surrey side of the Thames), was a long time member of the Road Runners Club and was the organisation's trophies secretary at the time of his death.

Over the years, hundreds of runners took part in his Battersea Park road races. In addition to the Monday races which at one time ran from May until September, but last summer were staged from mid-June to early August, he also put on Saturday morning road races over a variety of distances, from five miles to a marathon.

More recently, much to his frustration, they were reduced to a series of 10 kilometres races due to restrictions imposed by the Wandsworth Council, which manages the park.

Several years ago, the Saturday morning races were under threat, on the grounds of safety and inconvenience to other park users. I was pleased to be able to intervene on Tony's behalf with representations to appropriate members of Wandsworth Council, to ensure they continued. "We have organised these races for years, not for financial gains but as a service to runners and to encourage people to take up running," he stated in a letter he sent to the council last August.

He was also the long-time organiser of an annual 24-hour track race, staged at Tooting Bec track in recent years. Despite the impact of the brain tumour

which was diagnosed last year, he courageously managed to find the strength to assist with October's race - that was a sign of his enthusiasm and dedication.

In his business life he was the founder of the successful Run and Become group of shops starting with the one he ran in Victoria, Central London, established 23 years ago to serve the running community as a shop dedicated to running, being supplemented in recent years by others in Edinburgh and Cardiff.

In fact, Tony switched from a stable job in quantity surveying to open up the shop when he struggled to find a decent one with adequate stock which could also give him advice on running.

He is survived by his wife and two daughters.

There was standing room only at his funeral which took place at Mortlake Cemetery on March 7 which was attended by around 200 people.
