JEAN PECK

It is, with regret, we learn that Jean Peck passed away on 7th October following a prolonged period of ill health. Jean's primary involvement had been as Secretary of Selsonia Ladies AC. She became Hon Secretary of Surrey County WAAA, and in 1978 became their President (as was her husband Maurice in 1981). She was also Surrey Women's Team Manager. Subsequently she sat on both Southern (SCWAAA) and National (WAAA) committees. She was a Track Referee and later became a Great Britain Team Manager. She spent her latter years living in Hastings.

LAURIE TAITT

Laurie Taitt, who was one of Britain's top sprint hurdlers in the 1960's has died aged 72. Taitt, who competed for Herne Hill Harriers, began as a half-miler and high jumper at school but made his real mark as a sprint hurdler where he took the bronze medal at the Perth Commonwealth Games in 1962, representing England.

Born in British Guiana, he reached the sprint hurdles semi-final representing his native country at the 1958 then Empire Games in Cardiff. He gained his first British international vest in 1962 when he was runner-up and first UK finisher in the AAA championships. The following year he won the AAA indoor and outdoor sprint hurdles titles and at that time held the UK indoor records for 60 yards and 60m hurdles. He represented Britain at the 1964 Tokyo Olympics and also competed in the 1962 and 1966 European Championships and 1966 Commonwealth Games in Kingston, Jamaica.

He gained around a dozen international vests and was Herne Hill's most capped athlete. He was also a competent high jumper and admitted his most pleasing performance was clearing 1.88m in 1961. It goes without saying he won numerous Surrey titles and won the Inter-Counties championship four times from 1961 to 1963 and in 1966. His last competitive season was 1966.

SURREY COUNTY ATHLETICS SQUAD

The Surrey County Athletics Squad is gearing itself up for autumn and winter activities which will start with the first Squad Day on Saturday November 18th at Sutton Arena from 12noon - 6pm.

The aim of the series of days is to provide athletes, who have achieved the selection standard, and their coaches, the opportunity to attend winter training days which look at all aspects of athletics training.

Athletes and coaches will be introduced to the 5 Rings Model approach to training. The 5 Ring Model is currently being shared around the country by Dave Collins UKA Performance Director, Regional Coaches and hopefully by County Coaches to club coaches in the coming months.

Additionally, the Squad Days will provide all coaches in Surrey with the chance to learn from experienced coaches and their athletes.

The County Squad will build on the existing structure created by the Surrey Schools Association and will operate with direction from the new regional structure. The South East Region intends to provide athletes and coaches a pathway from County, through Regional to National level.

The Lead Coach & Coordinator for the Squad Geoff Platt will be work with the County Athletics Development Officer Lynsey Walton to organise the four training days which will be run primarily by experienced Surrey coaches.

Athletes and their coaches will shortly receive their invitation based on performances this summer.

Geoff is a former athlete who competed in multi events and later in shot and discus. As an athlete, coach and referee Geoff has been involved in the weightlifting world and is currently working on a PhD in Sports Science whilst teaching. He is very much involved with Surrey athletics as a Team Manager.

The intention is to open the Squad Days to all coaches who would like to attend, observe and learn from the training taking place.
