## *A. H. 'ROCKY' EYNON 1920 - 2007*

Rocky, a former President of the Surrey Womens AAA died on 2nd January 2007. His involvement with athletics started when his eldest daughter, Janet, joined Croydon Harriers in 1963. His other daughter, Elaine, joined the club subsequently. He was the club's women's team manager for 20 years and latterly became the Surrey Womens Team Manager. It was in recognition of his services to the County that he was elected President in 1988.

## *SURREY SQUAD DAY, SUTTON ARENA, 14 JANUARY 2007*
