Unfortunately the lead was not held on the final leg and the team finished third in 3:01.92.

Spa European Cup, First League A, Vaasa, Finland, 23/24 June 2007

Three Surrey athletes were part of the GB+NI team that won this First League fixture to qualify for the Super League in 2008. The busiest team member was **Joice Maduaka** (WG+EL) who gained 2 Firsts and 1 Second - 100m 2nd 11.32/+1.2; 200m 1st 23.31/-1.6 and 4x100m 1st 43.24. **Natasha Danvers-Smith** (SB) gained 2 victories - 400m Hurdles 1st 55.86 and 4x400m 1st 3:29.51. **Jade Johnson** (HHH) made a welcome return from injury and cleared 6.56m/0.7 to finish 2nd in the Long Jump.

IAAF World Youth (U18) Championships, Ostrava, Czech Republic, 11-15 July 2007

Michael Wheeler (HHH) represented GB+NI in the Shot Putt where he finished 19th overall with his qualifying round best of 18.19m. Had he been able to throw around his current best, a Surrey record, of 18.75m he would have finished 13th.

European U23 Championships, Debrecen, Hungary, 12-15 July 2007
