# **PETER SMITH 1920 - 2007**

Peter Smith died on 20th September 2007. Peter, a long-time member of Epsom & Ewell Harriers, was a Field Referee for many years and a regular attender of both County Championships and club events in that capacity. He was a Life Vice President of the Association.

## **COMPETITION REVIEW**

On 20<sup>th</sup> September 2007 UK Athletics issued "A future vision for track and field athletic competition" on their website. The proposals cover competition for athletes aged 20 and younger. Hopefully, by now, all clubs with an interest in track & field competition have been able to read the document and its appendices and come to a view on its contents. It is my understanding that if clubs wish to make comments they are expected to do this directly to UKA. There are no plans, that I am aware of, to hold forums where clubs can discuss and exchange views on the proposals. Indeed given the stated target "for a proposed implementation model to be published in December 2007" there was not much time allowed for such a process to be set up.

I have undertaken my own competition review - a review of the best performances by Surrey athletes for the past track & field season using the County rankings for the Under 13 and Under 15 age groups. I would expect these age groups to reflect any "Olympic effect" of increased numbers being attracted to our sport. The analysis is contained in an attachment to this issue of SCAN and is similar to that undertaken for the previous 2 years.

Although the figures show the relative strengths of our clubs it is based only on Surrey athletes so that clubs based outside the county may well be much stronger when their non-Surrey athletes are included. However, the main purpose of the analysis is to show the overall strength of athletics in Surrey. Using the premise that at grass roots level the numbers involved are more important than individual examples of excellence in measuring the strength of our sport - I have derived the following figures for the number of participants:

These figures show the number of girls showed a significant increase in 2007 whereas the boys had their corresponding increase in 2006 and have dropped back slightly in 2007. Does anyone have an explanation for this?

The attached analysis also shows a significant lack of depth in the field events and particularly the throws. In the NYAL Discus and Javelin are not held for Under 13s. I would recommend that anyone reviewing the programme for their meetings should attempt to redress this imbalance in order to encourage participation in these disciplines.
