Doug was a reliable cross country runner for Herne Hill Harriers without ever achieving huge success. As an administrator however he achieved great heights. He rose from the clubs cross country secretary during the early 1950s when the club enjoyed great success to become Surrey County secretary (1960 - 1969), Surrey County President (1971) & Southern Counties AAA President following in the steps on his brother Ron. He was team manager of the England team for the 1970 Edinburgh, 1974 Christchurch & 1978 Edmonton, Commonwealth Games teams & also managed the 1978 Great Britain team for the European Championships in Prague & 1976 Olympics Games teams in Montreal. An extremely distinguished & likeable man who had a kind word for everyone Doug will be sadly missed by all that knew him.

COMPETITION REVIEW

In the previous edition of SCAN I included an article which reviewed the number of athletes achieving County Standard performances as reported in the annual Track & Field for the years 2004-2007. I am pleased to report that this generated some response from readers. David Barrington (Kingston AC & Polytechnic Harriers) wrote:-

I wish I knew the answer to the fluctuations in numbers! However, my experience is that these things change with the wind. Sometimes clubs find a group of keen boys - or girls - who enhance their age groups for 2/3 years then disappear with no great volume in the years behind; then, a coach could gather a good group or a coach could retire. As for the Surrey numbers you compile, though, I would suggest it's more likely that your ranking lists have become more efficient/well known and the reporting levels have increased.I would not, personally, jump to ANY firm conclusions from stats. Far more likely to effect rankings are such imponderables as exams / family pressures / lack of, or sudden bursts of, commitment / lack of ability / easier recumbent things to do / desire for money / keeping up with peers etc.

I also received a suggestion from a coach, who specialises in field events, that participants in the less popular events would benefit from the setting of performance targets for the year ahead and they provided a sample of the procedure they have adopted to facilitate this:-

At the beginning of the season the coach discusses with the athlete which meetings are to be the significant ones for the season. They then agree the target performance for the next meeting which is recorded on a form (such as the one shown below). For events, such as the English Schools Championships, where entry standards apply, these are also noted. Then during the season the form is updated with the actual performance and the next target is set giving the athlete the opportunity to measure their progress. This can provide incentives in the less popular events where the vagaries of the standard and number of participants can make relative positions less relevant.
