So, if anybody can help, don't be shy, come forward and offer your services, you do not have to be qualified to pull a tape or to carry a hammer back or even write numbers down at the end of a race, your help would be greatly appreciated.

I must thank the Championships organising committee for providing competition and stimulus to all the athletes of the County, and in so doing improving the standards in the whole of British Athletics.


SPORTSHALL

Surrey had an outstanding day at the 2009 UK Sportshall finals, winning the Under 15 Boys title for the first time and taking third place in the Under 13 Girls contest. In addition, two Surrey athletes won the all-rounder awards. Both from Herne Hill, Funto Fabunmi-Alade provided the outstanding individual performance of the six hour meeting in breaking the 10-year-old standing long jump record with a leap of 2.76m and also won the vertical jump to win the under 15 girls title while Blade Ashby took the under 15 boys award winning the four lap race and standing long jump. It is the first time in the 19 years history of the event that a Surrey athlete has ever been an all-rounder winner. Christianne Risman (Guildford and Godalming) finished third in the girls all-rounders competition.
