SYLVESTER AKPALARA 1993 - 2010

It was with regret that we learnt from Steve Bosley that the young man who was shot and died on 29th December in Peckham was Sylvester Akpalara.

Sylvester had been a member of the Herne Hill Harriers since he was 12 and competed for the club in Ebbisham, NYAL & Southern Mens league matches as well as competing at London schools, Surrey County, Southern and National & three English Schools championships where he finished fifth and seventh in the 400m finals as a junior boy, indeed the last time I saw him run was in the heats of the U17 mens 400m at the National U17 champs in Bedford.

In 2008 he won a bronze medal in the final of the U15 boys 800m at the National U15 boys indoor championships in Birmingham as well at winning the U15 boys 400m outdoor title at the Surreys & third in the final of the Southern champs and he was nationally ranked in every year of his athletics career including 21st over 400m as an U17 in 2010 with a best of 50.4.

He was a quiet, unassuming lad who never griped about doing an extra event for his club and often ran himself close to exhaustion. He was reliable & rarely late for matches even if he had the furthest of most to travel to get to the coach. He enjoyed his athletics and made many friends both in the club and within the sport.

A Ceremony to remember his life was held on Thursday 13th January 2011 at Holy Trinity Church, Tooting. It was clear from the attendance that despite his youth Sylvester had made a significant impact upon the lives of his contemporaries both within athletics and beyond.

TED CAIGER 1936 - 2011

One of Surrey's top endurance runners of half-a-century ago, Ted Caiger, has died. Ted, who was 74 and lived in the USA, was third in the Surrey one mile championship in 1959 in 4:12.6 and was ranked third in the county with 4:08.5 that year. In 1960, he was fourth in the mile in 4:13.4 and ran 4:06.1 in the AAA championships at London's White City in July that year, ranking him fifth in the county. He also ran 1:54.5 for 880 yards that ranked him 10th in Surrey behind Brian Hewson (1:49.3) Mike Fleet (1:50.9) and Bob Harvey (1:53.8).

He was a member of Hercules AC (now Hercules Wimbledon) and was a good class cross country runner finishing 15th in the Surrey championships on Wimbledon Common in 1961, the same year he finished 57th in the English National. In 1964, he finished fourth in the Surrey six miles championship at Wimbledon Park in 30:18.0 behind Surrey AC's Barry Collins and twins Bob and Dave Holt, also from Hercules. His last recorded race was in 1965, at the age of 29, when he completed a marathon in Port Talbot, Wales, in 2:33:10

2010 TRACK & FIELD SEASON

Enclosed with this edition of SCAN is an analysis based upon the Surrey Ranking Lists of the performances of Surrey athletes in the Under 13 and Under 15 age groups.

This year's stats are not strictly comparable with those I have produced in previous years. This is because we changed some of the Surrey standards and the AAA of England standards used for this analysis are based on the 2009-10 standards. Therefore I have recalculated the figures for the years 2005 - 2009 using the revised standards so that the year by year comparisons are valid. Those of you with access to the internet can view the tabulations by clicking on the link at the bottom of the home page of the Surrey Athletics website.

It is from this group of athletes that the future of our sport will be made. I believe that we need to ensure that they are encouraged to participate in a range of events and to learn the disciplines of both training and competition. The numbers of athletes achieving the Surrey standard is a measure of how successful we are.

I would hope that clubs look at their figures and then ask themselves why their figures have stayed the same as previous years or have changed. By asking these questions the answers they get should be useful in planning their future development.

Clubs who seek financial support from bodies such as Sport England are asked to provide performance indicators so that they can be measured. I would suggest that the figures shown in the analysis could be used for this purpose.

Guildford & Godalming AC have dominated the 2 Girls age groups since 2005 which clearly shows that they are being successful. In the U15 Girls 4 of the top 6 clubs come from outside Greater London whereas in the U13 Girls it is 3 out of 6,

Herne Hill Harriers overtook Croydon Harriers as the leaders in the 2 Boys age groups which they have tended to share between them over the past 6 years. I note that in the U13 Boys 4 of the top 6 clubs come from the part of Surrey outside Greater London whereas in the U15 Boys only 1 club (Camberley & District) come from outside Greater London.

For the County overall in the Under 13 Girls there was a noticeable drop in the number of Grade Is in the technical events. For the Under 13 Boys there was notable improvement in the standard of our sprinters and over 800m but there was corresponding fall over 1500m! In the Under 15 Boys the quality at 400m & 800m showed a marked fall. For the Under 15 Girls there was a significant improvement at 75m Hurdles but little change elsewhere. What is noticeable across the age groups is the generally low level of attainment in the long throws. (not a new phenomenon) which suggests that this is a long-standing problem which needs to be addressed.
