Surrey County rules state that anyone entering a Surrey Championships, must be in possession of a current, and valid EA registration number.

U11s are not eligible to enter these championships.

Combined Events:

Guest entries may be accepted in all age groups, subject to an entry cap.

Masters Athletes:

Masters athletes may compete in the 3000m Steeplechase, but no age divisional medals will be awarded, and Senior barrier heights will be used.

Similarly Masters may enter the Senior Decathlon\Heptathlon, but will compete as Seniors, i.e. will use the Senior hurdle height and implement weights, with no application of WMA age factors.

Track Relays:

Entry is open to teams from SCAA affiliated clubs.

All team members must have a Surrey qualification see website.

Note that under UKA rule T3 S2, U13 and U15 athletes who are competing in a Combined Events are not allowed to compete in any other event on the same day.

While in accordance with Rule T24.10 clubs may enter squads and use up to four additional athletes as substitutes in each Relay team, they shall not, when separate multiple (e.g. "A" and "B") teams are entered, be permitted for a final to switch athletes between the teams that have separately taken part in heats, unless it can be demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Referee that such a substitution is necessary on medical grounds.

Team Managers:

- 1. Should enter and pay for teams by the closing date.
- 2. Declare athletes for each race, before race day.

*** Please note that the entry system will permit only one team manager per club ***

DATA PROTECTION:

For eligibility to compete, athletes provide personal data including a DOB, club affiliation, England Athletics registration number, contact information. This data is held on our system as a record of performances (PBs, CBPs, records). It may also be used as a way of providing information on future events etc.
