SURREY ELIGIBILITY	All athletes taking part must have either been born in Surrey or have residential claim. Surrey qualification rules can be found at <a href="http://www.surreyathletics.uk/qualification">http://www.surreyathletics.uk/qualification</a>			
REQUIREMENTS	All athletes must have a current and valid EA registration number before they can enter. EA numbers must be obtained from your club Membership Secretary. A valid email address must be provided with your entry.			
RESTRICTIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. U11'S are not eligible to enter these championships</li> <li>2. Pole vault minimum start height will be 2m</li> <li>3. Minimum Hammer throw is 20m</li> <li>4. U13s &amp; U15s can do either 800m or 1500m not both</li> <li>5. U13s &amp; U15s can compete in no more than 3 events on each day of the championships (800m heats and final will be on different days so will count towards this maximum on both days)</li> </ol>			
VESTS	UKA rule T5 S1(4) Athletes must wear the vest of their first-claim affiliated Club, their County, Area, District, Regional or National vest, or any other Representative vest approved by UKA.			
MEDALS	County medals will be awarded to the first three in each event
